Block ID	Icon	Name	Overview
1		Stone	Found very commonly underground
1:1		Granite	Found quite commonly underground
1:3		Diorite	Found quite commonly underground
1:5		Andesite	Found quite commonly underground
2		Grass Block	Extremely common; found on the surface
3		Dirt	Commonly found on the surface and uncommonly underground. Can be obtained by mining Grass Block
4		Cobblestone	Commonly found in Villages and Dungeons and can be obtained by mining Stone.
5		Wooden Planks	Commonly found in Villages and can be crafted from logs
7		Bedrock	Commonly found on layers 1-3, Protects players from falling into the void, can only be obtained in survival using inventory editors.
8		Water	Common fluid in Minecraft, found in all layers, found on River and Ocean Biomes, found on lakes. Can only be obtained from inventory editors.
9		Stationary Water	Can only be obtained in inventory editors, can be found on rivers with Caves naturally generated, changes back to water when block adjacent to it updates.
10		Lava	Uncommon block found underground and rarely on the surface. Moves slower than Water. Burns mobs. Can only be obtained through inventory editors.
11		Stationary Lava	Found on areas with slow terrain generation. Changes back to Lava when an adjacent block is updated.
12		Sand	Commonly found on River and Desert Biomes, found near bodies of water. Obeys gravity.
12:1		Red Sand	Found only on Mesa Biomes. Obeys gravity.
13		Gravel	Found underground and in Extreme Hills Biome. Obeys gravity.
14		Gold Ore	Rare ore found underground from layers 1 - 32. Drops itself when mined. Can be found at any layer in Mesa biomes.
15		Iron Ore	Common ore found underground and rarely on the surface from layers 1 - 64

17		Wood	Commonly found on the surface as a Tree.
17:1		Dark Oak Wood	Found on Roofed Forest. Dark Oak variant.
17:2		Birch Wood	Found in Birch Forest and Forest biomes
17:3		Jungle Wood	Found in Jungle biomes
18		Oak Leaves	Commonly found on the surface as a Tree. Drops Apples and Saplings.
18:1		Dark Oak Leaves	Commonly found on the surface as a Tree. Drops Saplings.
18:2		Birch Leaves	Commonly found on the surface as a Tree. Drops Saplings.
18:3		Jungle Leaves	Commonly found on the surface as a Tree. Drops Saplings.
21		Lapis Lazuli Ore	Uncommon ore that spawns in layers 1 - 16. Drops Lapis Lazuli when mined.
23		Dispenser	Found in Jungle Temples as part of an arrow trap
24		Sandstone	Commonly found on Desert Biomes.
24:1		Chiseled Sandstone	Commonly found in Desert Temples.
24:2		Smooth Sandstone	Commonly found on Desert Temples and Desert Villages.
29		Sticky Piston	Redstone device used to push or pull blocks. Found in Jungle Temples as part of trapdoor puzzle.
30		Cobweb	Commonly found in Abandoned Mineshafts, Stronghold Libraries, and Abandoned Villages.
31:1		Tall Grass	Commonly found on most biomes and rarely underground
31:2		Fern	Commonly found in Taiga, Mega Taiga, Extreme Hills, and Jungle biomes.
32		Dead Bush	Commonly found in Desert and Mesa biomes.
37		Dandelion	Commonly found in Plains and Flower Forest Biomes.
38		Flowers	Commonly found in Flower Forest Biomes.
39		Brown	Commonly found in dark places and in Mushroom Island Biomes.

















40		Red Mushroom	Commonly found in dark places and in Mushroom Island Biomes.
43		Double Stone Slabs	Found on Village Blacksmiths. Decoration blocks.
44		Slabs	Half-height blocks. Generates as Village Blacksmith rooftop.
46		TNT	Found in Desert Temples as traps. Destroys blocks in radius.
47		Bookshelf	Commonly found in Libraries.
48		Moss Stone	Commonly found in Mossy Cobblestone Boulders and Dungeons
49		Obsidian	Commonly found in Lava Lakes when water passes them.
50		Torch	Commonly found in Villages, Abandoned Mineshafts, and Strongholds.
51		Fire	Commonly found when something is burning next to Lava Lakes or Village Blacksmiths
52		Monster Spawner	Commonly found in Dungeons
53		Oak Wood Stairs	Commonly found in Villages
54		Chest	Commonly found in Dungeons, Villages, Strongholds. Contain loot.
55		Redstone Wire	Placed Redstone wiring. Found in Jungle Temples as part of trapdoor puzzle.
56		Diamond Ore	Rare ore found underground from layer 5-16. Drops 1 Diamond.
58		Crafting Table	Commonly found in Village Libraries
59		Crops	Commonly found in Village Farms
60		Farmland	Commonly found in Village Farms
61		Furnace	Commonly found in Village Blacksmiths.
64		Wooden Door	Commonly found in Village Houses
65		Ladder	Commonly found in Village Huts
66		Rail	Commonly found in Abandoned Mineshafts

69		Lever	Provides redstone signal. Found in Jungle Temple as part of trapdoor puzzle.
73		Redstone Ore	Common ores found underground below layer 16. Drop Redstone Dust when mined.
74		Glowing Redstone Ore	Redstone ores that have been interacted or touched.
78		Top Snow	Commonly found in cold biomes.
79		Ice	Commonly found in Frozen Rivers.
80		Snow (block)	Commonly found in Ice Spike Biomes.
81		Cactus	Commonly found in Desert Biomes.
82		Clay Block	Commonly found in Rivers. Drop Clay when mined.
83		Sugarcane	Commonly found next to water.
85		Oak Fence	Commonly found as part of Abandoned Mineshafts, behind Village Houses and tables.
86		Pumpkin	Rare blocks that found in small patches in Plain, Taiga or Savannah biomes.
93/94		Redstone Repeater	Boosts and delays Redstone signals. Found in Jungle Temple as part of trapdoor puzzle.
97		Monster Egg	Commonly found in Extreme Hill Biomes and strongholds. Spawns Silverfish when mined.
98		Stone Brick	Commonly found in Strongholds.
99		Brown Mushroom	Commonly found on Giant Brown Mushrooms. Drops Brown Mushroom when mined.
100		Red Mushroom (Block)	Commonly found on Giant Red Mushrooms. Drops Red Mushroom when mined.
101		Iron Bars	Commonly found in Village Blacksmiths and Strongholds.
102		Glass Pane	Commonly found in Villages as windows.
103		Melon Block	Commonly found in Jungle Biomes.
106		Vines	Commonly found on trees.
110		Mycelium	Commonly found on Mushroom Island Biomes. Spreads to











111		Lily Pads	Commonly found in Swamp Biomes. Can be placed above Water blocks.
118		Cauldron	Commonly found in Witch Huts.
120		End Portal Frame	Commonly found in Strongholds, in portal room.
127		Cocoa Bean	Commonly found in Jungle Biomes.
128		Sandstone Stairs	Commonly found in Desert Villages.
129		Emerald Ore	Rare ore found underground in Extreme Hill Biomes. Drops Emerald when mined.
131		Tripwire Hook	Found in Jungle temple as part of arrow trap.
141		Carrot	Commonly found in Village Farms as a crop.
142		Potato	Commonly found in Village Farms as a crop.
159		Terracotta	Commonly found in Mesa Biomes.
161		Leaves	Commonly found on Acacia Trees. Drop Saplings.
161:1		Dark Oak (Leaves)	Commonly found on Dark Oak Trees. Drop Saplings.
162		Acacia Wood	Commonly found on Trees.
162:1		Dark Oak Wood	Commonly found on Dark Oak Trees.
165		Slime Block	Rarely found in Swamp biome.
168		Prismarine	Commonly found in Ocean Monument.
169		Sea Lantern	Commonly found in Ocean Monument.
171		Carpet	Commonly found in Villages as part of tables.
172		Hardened Clay	Commonly found in Mesa biomes.
174		Packed Ice	Commonly found in Ice Spike biomes.
175		Large Flowers	Commonly found in small patches in Plain and Extreme Hill Biomes. These are two blocks high.

244		Beetroot	Commonly found in Villages.
243		Podzol	Found in the Mega Taiga Biome.

10		Lava	Common block found underground and on the surface. Burns mobs. Can only be obtained through Inventory Editors
11		Stationary Lava	Found on areas with slow terrain generation. Changes back to lava when adjacent block is updated.
13		Gravel	Found underground and on the surface. Obeys gravity.
49		Obsidian	Spawn as Portal frame.
51		Fire	Commonly found on the surface.
52		Monster Spawner	Commonly found in Nether Fortresses.
54		Chest	Commonly found in Nether Fortresses. Contain loot.
87		Netherrack	Commonly found anywhere.
88		Soul Sand	Commonly found on the surface and in Nether Fortresses.
89		Glowstone	Commonly found as Glowstone Cluster
90		Nether Portal Block	Spawns within the Nether Portal.
112		Nether Brick Block	Commonly found in Nether Fortresses.

130		Ender Chest	Entity. Used to store and protect items and blocks. Found in End Cities.
198		End Rod	Used as a light source. Commonly found in End Cities.
199		Chorus Plant	When broken, it yields Chorus Fruit.
200		Chorus Flower	Grows on Chorus Plants.
201		Purpur Block	A Decorative Block. Commonly found in End Cities.
202		Purpur Pillar	A Decorative Block. Commonly found in End Cities.
205		Purpur Slab	A Decorative Block. Commonly found in End Cities.
206		End Stone Brick	A Decorative Block. Commonly found in End Cities.

20		Glass	Semi-transparent decorative blocks. Acquired by smelting Sand.
22		Block of Lapis Lazuli	Building block
25		Note Block	Produces tones when powered by a Redstone power. Tones can be altered by interacting with it.

27		Powered Rail	Speeds Minecarts when powered by Redstone.
28		Detector Rail	Produces Redstone power when Minecarts pass through it.
33		Piston	Redstone device used to push blocks
35		Wool	Dropped by Sheep. Decorative blocks.
41		Block of Gold	Decoration blocks. Obtained through crafting.
42		Block of Iron	Decoration blocks. Used to spawn Iron Golems.
45		Bricks (Block)	Decoration blocks. Obtained through crafting.
57		Block of Diamond	Decoration blocks. Obtained through crafting.
62		Furnace (Active)	Replaces Furnace during smelting. Reverts back to a Furnace when finished.
63/68		Sign	Decorative block, used to display letters on it
70/72		Pressure Plate	Provides redstone source when an entity is on top of it
71		Iron Door	A door that only opens by redstone signal and can not be broken by zombies.
75/76		Redstone Torch	Provides light and a redstone source that can be switched off
77/143		Button	Provides temporary redstone source
91		Jack O'Lantern	A decorative block that provides a light source
92		Cake	A block that is also a food item.
96		Trapdoor	Provides access through roof or floor and can be used to trick mobs into falling
107		Fence Gate	Allows player passage through fences
116		Enchantment Table	Mechanics block, used to enchant player items
117		Brewing Stand	Mechanics block, used to brew Potions
123/124		Redstone Lamp	Redstone device that provides a switchable light source

133		Block of Emerald	Building block
137/188/189		Command Block	Used to execute in-game commands
138		Beacon	Used to provide Status Effects to players in the vicinity.
139		Cobblestone Wall	Non-flammable fence.
140		Flower Pot	Used to display vegetation
144		Mob Head	Decorative, if not macabre, block. In item form, can also be used as helmet/mask.
145		Anvil	Mechanics block, Used to enchant, repair, rename items and tools. Obeys gravity.
146		Redstone Comparator	Redstone-mechanics Block that outputs the difference of input redstone signal strengths
149/150		Trapped Chest	Used to store items and provides redstone source when opened.
151/178		Daylight Sensor	Produces redstone signal strength in proportion to the intensity of light
152		Block of Redstone	Redstone-mechanics Block
155		Block of Quartz	Building block
167		Iron Trapdoor	Same function as a wooden trapdoor, but requires redstone signal to open
170		Hay Bale	Decorative blocks.
173		Block of Coal	Fuels, a building block
179		Red Sandstone	Decoration blocks. Obtained through crafting.
198		Grass Path	Decorational block. Created by tapping a Grass block with a shovel.
207		Frosted Ice	Same properties as Ice. Generated by player use of Frostwalker enchantment.
218		Shulker Box	Container for items. Differs from a chest in that it still contains items when broken and carried an item itself.
219-235		Glazed Terracotta	Decoration blocks. Obtained through crafting.
236		Concrete	Decoration blocks. Obtained through crafting.
